What is Allowed?

Fires contained within liquid or gas fueled appliances that can be shut off.



Only the permitted, professional fireworks displays are allowed. It is the decision of the local jurisdiction to host a frieworks display.

What is **NOT** Allowed?

Building, maintaining, attending, or using an open fire (including charcoal grills), either in a campground or at a private residence.



Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building. Dispose of smoking materials in places where they cannot be a source of ignition. NEVER throw them from car windows.



The possession, use and sale of permissible fireworks is prohibited.



Operating a chainsaw without an USDA or SAE approved spark-arresting device properly installed and in working order. Welding or operating torches with open flame.
