- See dates on the other side of this pamphlet for the mitigation plan.
- Drag slash from your property into the right-of-way along identified roads before the below date.
- Slash Requirements\*
  -Slash must be 10" diameter or less
  - -Maximum pile size per property is 8 ft x 8 ft x 3 ft
  - -No construction materials
  - -No materials with nails or fasteners
  - -No firewood
- We masticate and chip for free!

Dead/downed trees and slash in the right of way will be chipped and/or masticated, and broadcast back on the roadside at a maximum depth of 4".
