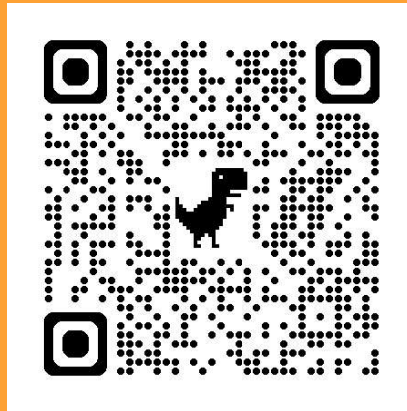
## How to Participate

- 1 See dates on the other side of this pamphlet for the mitigation plan.
- 2 Drag slash from your property into the right-of-way along identified roads before the below date.
- 3 **Slash Requirements\***
  - Slash must be 10" diameter or less
  - Maximum pile size per property is 8 ft x 8 ft x 3 ft
  - No construction materials
  - No materials with nails or fasteners
  - No firewood
- 4 **We masticate and chip for free!**

Dead/downed trees and slash in the right of way will be chipped and/or masticated, and broadcast back on the roadside at a maximum depth of 4".

## County Roads 41, 4110, 412, 413, 414, 42

- **Machinery and crews may be in the area as early as October 1st.**
- Slash must be pulled into the right of way by **October 7th, 2025**
- Right of way is **within 10 feet** of the County Road.
- **Private Roads will not be treated.**
