



Grand County Stage 2 Fire Restriction Information



As of August 13, 2020, at 12:00pm, Grand County instated **STAGE 2** fire restrictions regarding open burning. To read the entire resolution go to: co.grand.co.us. All law enforcement and fire agencies throughout Grand County would like to thank everyone for their compliance and cooperation with our current fire restrictions. Remember, one small spark can cause a devastating wildfire! Be safe!!

What is **NOT** Allowed?



Building, maintaining, attending, or using an open fire (including charcoal grills), either in a campground or at a private residence. No outdoor fires unless it is gas and can be turned OFF.



The possession, use and sale of permissible fireworks is prohibited. Only the permitted, professional fireworks displays are allowed. It is the decision of the local jurisdiction to host a fireworks display.



Welding or operating torches with an open flame is prohibited.



The use of incendiary devices such as explosives, exploding or tracer ammunition, exploding targets, or rockets is prohibited.



Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building. Dispose of smoking materials in places where they cannot be a source of ignition. NEVER throw them from car windows.



Operating a chainsaw (or any other internal/external combustion engine) without an USDA or SAE approved spark-arresting device properly installed and in working order.
